### 2010 CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

#### For Competitors, Coaches, and Support Staff on the Infield

1. In order to better serve the interests of those who are participating at the VALLEY PREFERRED CYCLING CENTER have adopted this Code of Conduct.
2. To this end, I pledge to uphold the spirit of this Code of Conduct, which offers a general guide to my conduct as a rider, coach, or support staff during the racing year 2009 at the VALLEY PREFERRED CYCLING CENTER. I recognize that this Code does not establish a complete set of rules that prescribes every aspect of appropriate behavior. Further, I:
  - will respect the property of others whether personal or public;
  - will respect the athletes competing, other coaches, VALLEY PREFERRED CYCLING CENTER staff, spectators, volunteers, race officials, medical staff and engage in no form of verbal, physical or sexual harassment or abuse
  - will remember that at all times I am an ambassador for my sport;
  - will not bring alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs into the infield
  - will not enter the infield if inebriated;
3. Alleged violations of the VPCC Code of Conduct must be reported to the Chief Referee or VALLEY PREFERRED CYCLING CENTER staff or management..
4. Failure to abide by the above rules is grounds for dismissal from the infield and/or the facility if deemed necessary by the Chief Referee or VALLEY PREFERRED CYCLING CENTER Management or Staff.
